Lisa Skibenes will guide the kids through the process of creating their target project of a mosaic (like the yellow bird) and acrylic mural painted on the parking lot side of the Le Hatchery building. Each child will sign their piece of the project right on the wall. Heidi Wetzel will help each student to create a woven sculpture of something they can

take home and use. In addition, several other resident artists will demonstrate various art media.
